Observations from Above Data

- Increased membership by 5 members

- Decline in number of tournaments as well (for the same reasons)
- Increased # of matches (by more than 550)
- Increased payout by (over \$76,000)
- Increased # of playoff matches due to UIL assignments and TAPPS Regional Semifinals
