- 91-120 mile travel range rates. This is expensive for the distant schools.
 - o Mileage is not intended to be part of the pay, it is meant to be compensation
- Travel pay rates have changed, but this should only affect our chapter during playoffs
- They discussed awards, procedures and policies
- Updates to the uniform policy: TASO approved jackets will be approved
- Coming: Teams which make playoffs 'may' be able to select their officials for playoffs
- Question about late fees: April 15th, this message does not come out early enough from TASO.

Information from TASO Off-Season Meeting

RETENTION - Top 5 Reasons Officials Do Not Return

- 1) Move to another job
- 2) Family issues
- 3) Abuse from fans and coaches
- 4) Chapter Politics ("Dictator" management style)
- 5) Aging demographics (Sometimes it is just time to retire.)

TASO sends a survey to all officials who do not renew.

MINIMUM AGE TO BECOME A TASO OFFICIAL

Used to be 17 years of age.

• Starting with 2020 season, the minimum age will be 16 years of age.

 Assigning secretaries can decide what level of match these younger officials can handle.

Assigning Secretary Report



- With realignment coming out this week she is working on contacting coaches.
- Also we have several new schools contacting us.
- We are considering not using pay sheets, the school will be responsible to print them out if they want them.
- Scrimmages are only beginning to be planned







Trainer Report



- She is getting things ready, nothing significant to report
- Will be inviting Trainers to join the training team.
 - o The training team is limited to level 2 and 1
 - The training team is limited to 'invitation only'
 - Should we continue using 'invitation only'?
 - We are seeking consistency
 - We are not wanting to teach 'this is how we used to do it'
 - o Being a good official does not necessarily translate to being a good trainer
 - o Board agreed we should continue to limit the trainers to 'invitation only'
 - o Suggested we send out a new invite to see who is interested and select the 2020 team
 - 2019 season we had more trainers than we needed, except San Marcos which is limited
 - Several board members supported Christle and her team should choose the trainers which will be most successful at training.
- Revised rating sheet in 2019 based on USAV, USAV has changed their sheet, should we change ours. Most officials are new and use the old 'Eval' form instead of the rating sheet.
- Orientations will be all on WebEx. Each level of Plan requires either volleyball officiating or some level of officiating. She will send out a summary for us to review.







Other Business



Chapter Center Point (for mileage)

- o Time for us to review the center point again.
- o The center point is based on what is best for the schools
 - There are more officials north and more schools north.
 - We send more officials south from north and they do not get a fair compensation because of the travel
 - Dripping Springs as an example is 25 miles (at 30 miles it would be more money)
 - o Tayler is 31 miles
 - A comment about people calling the level of play at different schools was concerning.
 - o This is a complex decision
 - o Football, baseball and softball all use the same center point

Budget Review: See Budget Slide Below

- We reviewed the budget, scrimmage money is the biggest concern, we will monitor it over this next season
- o State tournament travel will likely need to be raised because it is at Allen, TX. We will estimate \$425
- o ~<\$1,200> loss is the final number
- o Conversation about the whole chapter meeting meal. Officials really like the meal (though not pizza).
 - We want to ensure we have a good meal at the season kickoff meeting. We could reduce it at the season ending meeting.
 - Chez will be the meal coordinator.
- o Motion to approve: Janiece, Seconded by Tyler: Approved by unanimous decision

Arbiter Update

- We met with Arbiter to see if they can do all our tracking in Arbiter, we hope we can and then we can stop using a spreadsheet. Things like training and events. This will enable us to use Arbiter to track attendance.
- o No extra costs, but some custom fields may be needed.
- o The key question is can we run reports on the attendance
- o Evaluations: We do not pay for this module, but it is only \$99 and might be worth having for our training
- We noticed many of the fees when up in our Arbiter bill, they did not tell us they were raising the rates
