

4. *Click* **Check Status** to see if your email is blocked. You will get one of two messages, either a **green OK** or a **red Blocked**.





5. If blocked, *click* **Unblock Email** below the status. Once this is clicked, the email is removed from the block list and future emails should start coming through.

Remove your email address from the "blocked" list.

Unblock Email

My email is not blocked, but I do not get notifications.

Going through the process listed above will remove you from our blocked list. However, this does not guarantee that you will receive notifications. There may be additional issues with your email that are solved by other means.

Adding messaging@arbitersports.com as a contact in your email address and contacting your email provider may be necessary steps to ensure that you start receiving these emails. If you have gone through this and things still are not working, it would be best to reach out to your email provider for more information.













To see schedule- select schedule, calendar, list view, Future, All, All, and Apply Filter.




When assigned you receive an email and a text if you have signed up for text messages. When a match is deleted you receive an email and a text message.



HOW DO I SELF ASSIGN?



If you have completed training and wish to self assign:


- 1. Select schedule tab.
- 2. Select Self assign.
- 3. I recommend leaving start date, levels as is. This gives you all the self assignable matches.
- 4. Select Search.
- 5. Select Go!



What if I can't see any matches available for self assign?


- It is possible that your travel limits are set to low for the matches that are still open.
- It is possible that the school has set travel limits to low.
- All the matches are outside the 30 days.
- Arbiter anticipates travel times based on your leave time entered on your blocks.


HOW DO I SET UP BLOCKS- TRAVEL LIMITS, ETC

BLOCK FULL DAY?




SEE DATE AT THE BOTTOM- TO REMOVE CLICK ON X

Trainer Report



Member Questions/Concerns:

- FLAGS: If officials do not wish to share their flags with the linesmen, it is acceptable for the linesmen to use flags that might be provided by the school or they may use hand signals to perform their responsibilities.
- GAITER FACE MASKS: It is permissible for officials to wear gaiter face masks. They must be a solid color..
- Pre-match meeting with NO coin toss.
- Safety when checking ball pressure.
- Use of an electronic whistle





Pre-Match Conference

R1 Conducts the Pre-match Conference with the 1 Captain from HEAD Coach from each team at center court.

Cover same information as you always have.

- Introductions
- Ground Rules/Unusual obstructions
- Court Lines
- Jewelry/Uniforms
- Reminders & Expectations
- Intermissions/Special events (Don't ask)

- Remind coaches to place the rosters on the scorer table.
- Warm-up times
- Q&A
- "Let's have a Good match"





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

- R2, Your answer, when asked "if you have anything to add?" should not be "NO".
- Remember the rule considerations this year pertaining to the roster at the captains meeting.











New Business



- -Masks: Thang Nugyen mask is okay if you cover up the logo
- -Electronic whistles are NOT required but may be used, be sure to practice with them
- -Scrimmage plans will come out Thursday and Friday
- -Masks are being required into and out of ALL school facilities. They are not currently required of officials while participating in a match. It is the official's choice if they wish to wear them during the match and pregame match activities.
